Omaha, Nebr. – Today, Douglas County Election Commissioner Dave Phipps released the turnout prediction for the 2009 City of Omaha General Election of 31 percent.

As of May 1, 2009, there are 241,803 voters registered in the City of Omaha, including 86,746 Republicans, 106,087 Democrats, and 48,970 Nonpartisan. Thirty-one percent of those voters would amount to nearly 74,959 votes.

“In 2001, more than 108,000 people cast their ballot, while in 2005 there were more than 62,000.” Phipps said.

Voting for the General Election is Tuesday, May 12, 2009. Polls are open from 8:00 a.m. until 8:00 p.m.
